

INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXECUTION OF A WILL

- A. Testator should take the following steps, in the order indicated, in the presence of two adult witnesses and a notary, none of whom is a person who will receive benefits under the Will. If possible an attorney should supervise (and may be one of the witnesses):
1. Testator should state to the witnesses:
 - a. "This document is my Will."
 - b. "I have read the document."
 - c. "This document represents my wishes."
 - d. "I would like you to be the witnesses to this Will."
 2. Testator should initial each page of the Will at the foot of the page.
 3. Testator should fill in the date in the spaces provided in the paragraph immediately above the signature line at the end of the Will
 4. Testator should sign the Will on the indicated line below the date. Testator should also sign the Self-Proving Affidavit, page after the signature page.
- B. The witnesses should then sign their names and fill in their addresses in the spaces provided on the signature page of the Will. They should also fill out the Affidavit attached to the Will with their names printed in the first paragraph and sign before a notary on page two (2) of such Affidavit. The Testator and all of the witnesses must be present throughout and see one another sign.
- C. No one (Testator and witnesses) should leave the room until the entire procedure has been completed.
